eSource


Clinical trials are built on data, but the way that data is captured can make or break a study's speed and quality.

At the inaugural Digital Health Canada Manitoba Breakfast, we celebrated 20 years of digital health leadership within the First Nations Health and Social Secretariat of Manitoba (FNHSSM)—a milestone marked alongside the 50th anniversary of Digital Health Canada.

Highlights included Al-bots that cut vaccine data entry time by 80% and Manitoba's immunization query service—the first of its kind in Canada and developed and deployed with First Nations. The Manitoba Advantage was clearly on display, with conversations reinforcing the province's leadership in digital sovereignty, interoperability, and positioning itself as a national testbed for scalable health innovations like virtual care through QDoc.
