

In <u>our latest webinar</u>, we explored how Canada's clinical research ecosystem can strengthen its global competitiveness through digital readiness, inclusive recruitment, and collaboration across provinces.

Key Insights

Canada's Strengths: High diversity, world-class AI research talent, and efficient Health Canada review timelines make Canada uniquely positioned for innovation in clinical research.

Systemic Challenges: Fragmented digital infrastructure, complex ethics and privacy processes, and uneven site capacity continue to delay trial startups and limit patient access.

Provincial Success Stories:

Clinical Trials Ontario (CTO) – Well-established streamlined single ethics review, CTO Stream, and the QuickSTART program working towards the goal of study activation in 45 days.

platform powered by Sciteline, supporting over 350 trials and driving engagement, insights, and capacity building through integrated recruitment, registry, eSource, and DCT tools.

NovaStudies Connect (Nova Scotia) – A patient-centered clinical trials

RITHIM (Manitoba) – Unified approval platform for ethics, privacy, and institutional reviews recently launched and adoption is underway.

Pan-Canadian Initiatives: 3CTN, CanReview, and ACT Consortium, are driving collaboration, capacity building, and efficiency nationwide.

Decentralized Clinical Trials (DCTs): The CRAFT model, adapted from the Australasian Teletrial Program, enables smaller, research-naive, and remote sites to participate through hub-and-spoke networks, expanding access and capacity across regions.

Next Steps for Sites

- Build digital and DCT readiness through workflow updates and training.
- Leverage registries and pre-screened databases for more inclusive, efficient recruitment.
